With the help of 45 volunteers CPO was able to gather white tagged items to use in our "Pre-school Clothing Corner" (newborns—toddlers as well as maternity) from the Fall KidsEveryWear consignment sale. We appreciate all the sellers that white tag their items (items that are marked for donation if they do not sell). Our volunteers worked hard to remove all clothing from hangers, remove all tags and bag them for transport. This will be a good foundation for our Fall/Winter clothing inventory. *Unfortunately, since CPO depends solely on donations for our clothing corner, the demand outstrips our supply so we are still looking for donations from any and all sources that CPO can reach!*
